**Children's Subject: Maker of

Activity: Sky, Sea, or Land?

Invite a volunteer up to act out an animal or action from the air, sea, or land. Have the rest of the class guess where it belongs.

Once the class guesses where the animal belongs, have all the kids do the action together before picking the next volunteer!
